## ATTENTION PARENTS OF FALL 2017 PreK AND KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS:

Your child must have required immunizations and school physicals before entering school Sept. 5, 2017. If your child has not had a physical completed by their medical provider after Sept. 5, 2016, you must schedule an appointment. A completed state school entrance health form signed by your child's medical provider, is required before school starts. Go to the Patient Info/Forms page on [esrh.org](http://esrh.org) to download the form and complete the parent information section prior to the appointment. If your child received a physical after Sept. 5, 2016, at Rural Health the child's medical provider will complete the form once the parent has filled out their portion and delivered it to the center where the child is a patient.

## ATTENTION PARENTS OF FALL 2017 6TH GRADERS:

Your child must have a booster dose of the Tdap vaccine before starting 6th grade. To get immunizations at Rural Health, call your center and ask for a nurse appointment if your child does not have a well child annual exam scheduled before school begins Sept. 5 but has had a physical within the last year.

## ATTENTION PARENTS OF STUDENT ATHLETES:

A sports physical and a completed Virginia High School League physical exam form, signed by your child's medical provider, is required before your child can try out for middle school and high school teams. A new form must be submitted each school year. Go to the Patient Info/Forms page on [esrh.org](http://esrh.org) to download the form. If your child has received a physical within the last year at Rural Health the child's medical provider will complete the form once the parent has filled out their portion and delivered it to the center where the child is a patient.
