

## ATTENTION PARENTS OF FALL 2018 PreK AND KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS:

Your child must have required immunizations and school physicals before entering school Sept. 4, 2018. If your child has not had a well child check/physical completed by their medical provider after Sept. 4, 2017, they will need to schedule an appointment to have a physical completed.

## ATTENTION PARENTS OF CURRENT 5TH GRADERS:

Your child must have a booster dose of the Tdap vaccine before starting 6th grade. To get immunizations at Rural Health, call your center and ask for a nurse appointment if your child does not have a well child annual exam scheduled before school begins Sept. 4, 2018, but has had a well child check/physical within the last year.

## ATTENTION PARENTS OF STUDENT ATHLETES:

A sports physical and a completed Virginia High School League physical exam form, signed by your child's medical provider, is required before your child can try out for middle school and high school teams. A new, updated form must be submitted each school year. Go to the Patient Info/Forms page on [esrh.org](http://esrh.org) to download the form. If your child has received a well child check/physical within the last year at Rural Health the child's medical provider will complete the sports physical form once the parent has filled out their portion and delivered it to the Rural Health center where your child is a patient.

Sports physicals, required immunizations for Kindergarten and 6th grade students and well child checks/physicals required for PreK and Kindergarten prior to entering school will be available the following special hours.

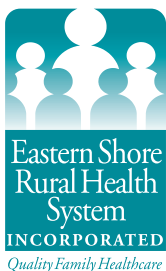
**Atlantic Community Health Center: June 18 and 25 and July 9 and 16 from 4:30 p.m. to 6 p.m.**
